In addition to grants and initiatives, BluePearl Cares shares the talent and expertise of BluePearl Associates with nonprofit and animal welfare organizations that have limited resources and veterinary teams. We do this through:

Care in communities by giving back through BluePearl Cares Care Corps.

Care in hospitals by empowering Associates to support pets in need through the HOPE Funds grant program.

Care in shelters by elevating high-quality veterinary care for shelter pets.

BluePearl Cares Care Corps

Our BluePearl Cares Care Corps program deploys volunteer veterinary professionals to train, mentor and provide veterinary care to those in under-resourced communities that have limited or no access to care, as well as those impacted by disasters. As the nation faces a dire shortage of veterinary professionals, volunteers increase our nonprofit partners' ability to serve pets and communities in need.

Veterinary Medical Equipment Grant

Local shelters do their best to help community pets receive critical veterinary care while also preparing shelter animals for their forever home. Our grants provide critical funding for medical equipment, a cost that's often out of reach for many nonprofit partners as they work to increase access to care for both owned and shelter pets.

BluePearl Cares launched our first Veterinary Medical Equipment Grant cycle in September 2024, inviting animal welfare partners to apply for funding to help expand care for pets in their community. SPCA Florida, located in Lakeland just outside of Tampa, cares for more than 6,000 pets annually while also providing affordable, quality veterinary care for more than 4,500 clients each month. One of our very first grant recipients, SPCA Florida used funds to purchase a new surgery table for its medical center so it can increase care for both shelter and owned pets in their hometown and across the state.

HOPE Funds

Helping Overcome Pet Emergencies or HOPE—Funds provides financial support for income-qualifying clients in hospitals.

550 pets impacted 69 hospitals \$628,000
